67.01 PEDESTRIAN DEFINED. "Pedestrian" as it is used in this chapter means a person who is walking on foot, or a person who travels by way of roller blades, skateboards or in-line skates.

67.02 WALKING IN STREET. Pedestrians shall at all times when walking on or along a street, walk on the left side of the street. (*Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.326*)

67.03 HITCHHIKING. No person shall stand in the traveled portion of a street for the purpose of soliciting a ride from the driver of any private vehicle. *(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.331)*

67.04 PEDESTRIAN CROSSING. Every pedestrian crossing a roadway at any point other than within a marked crosswalk or within an unmarked crosswalk at an intersection shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles upon the roadway.

(*Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.328*)

67.05 USE SIDEWALKS. Where sidewalks are provided it is unlawful for any pedestrian to walk along and upon an adjacent street. Those pedestrians on roller blades, skateboards and in-line skates are exempted from this provision if they can show by a preponderance of the evidence that the condition of the sidewalk poses an unreasonable risk of injury to or threatens the safety of other pedestrians or themselves.
