a) Discussion: Fountain Status Update – Alan Schumacher

Schumacher reported delivery of fountain structure unknown due to current supply chain issues. Final installation now targeted for spring 2022. Will be completing the reservoir install and reinforcing base under fountain basin prior to December 4.

Kensler reported developing rezoning requirements overview. Continuing to work through legal descriptions for 1001 E. Main property. Marck reported have received 125 LMI survey responses. ECICOG planning door-to-door inquiries week of November 29. Received update that CDBG applications for waste water projects will not be accepted in January; next application period is April 2022.

Rabe reported that pool committee recommended JEO for consideration of project concept and feasibility discussions. Targeting January to provide initial project scope to council.
